Description: Esomeprazole, the S-isomer of omeprazole, is the first proton pump inhibitor (PPI) synthesized as an optical isomer to become available for clinical use. Esomeprazole is approved for the healing and maintenance of erosive esophagitis, for symptomatic gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD), for use in combination with antibiotics to eradicate *Helicobacter pylori* (*H. pylori*) in patients with active or prior duodenal ulcer disease, for risk reduction of NSAID-associated gastric ulcer, for risk reduction of upper GI rebleeding after therapeutic endoscopy, and for pathological hypersecretory conditions, including Zollinger-Ellison syndrome. 26477 55689 Esomeprazole has a greater bioavailability compared to omeprazole, which may contribute to higher healing rates reported in studies of erosive esophagitis. 26481 On the basis of available research, no clear advantage has been demonstrated for the use of one PPI over another in the treatment of GERD. Instead, a key to optimizing effectiveness is tailoring dosage timing and considering twice daily dosing; traditional delayed release PPIs should be administered 30–60
